In the case of domestic employees only 4 of the paid public holidays are applicable and these include:New years Day,Good Friday,Independence Day,and Christmas Day Alone. A minimum of 15 working days of paid leave is given per year. At least 8 leave days must be taken within 6 months of the leave earning period.

Contracts of employment may be oral or in writing, expressed or implied. However, any work which falls outside of Botswana or as may be specified by the Minister of Labour, the employment contract must be in writing. Normal working hours in Botswana are 8 hours a day and 48 hours a week. An employee is not required under his contract of employment to work more than five consecutive hours without a period of rest which is not be less than 30 minutes or more than an ordinary working period of eight hours in any one day or more than 48 hours in any one week.
