Gerunds & Infinitives - Meaning, Examples & Exercises

The gerund is formed using the ending " -ing " (walking, eating, etc ...). As we saw in the verbs lesson, the infinitive is formed using the preposition " to " (to walk, to eat, etc ...). The gerund and the infinitive are forms of verbs that act as nouns.
